### EndNote: Transferring Citations from PubMed

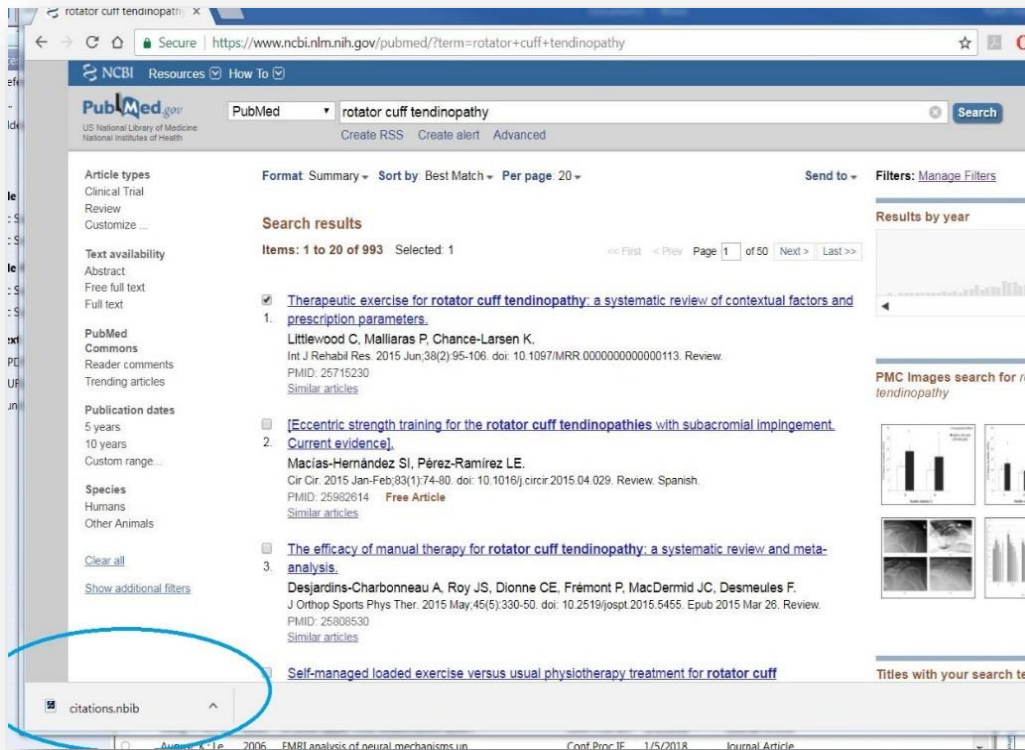
There are many ways to add citations to your EndNote library. Many resources, like PubMed, provide simple solutions for transferring citations directly into Endnote.

- 1) Run a search in PubMed. Select the items you'd like to export into your EndNote library. Then click on **SEND TO**, select "Citation Manager", and "Create File."

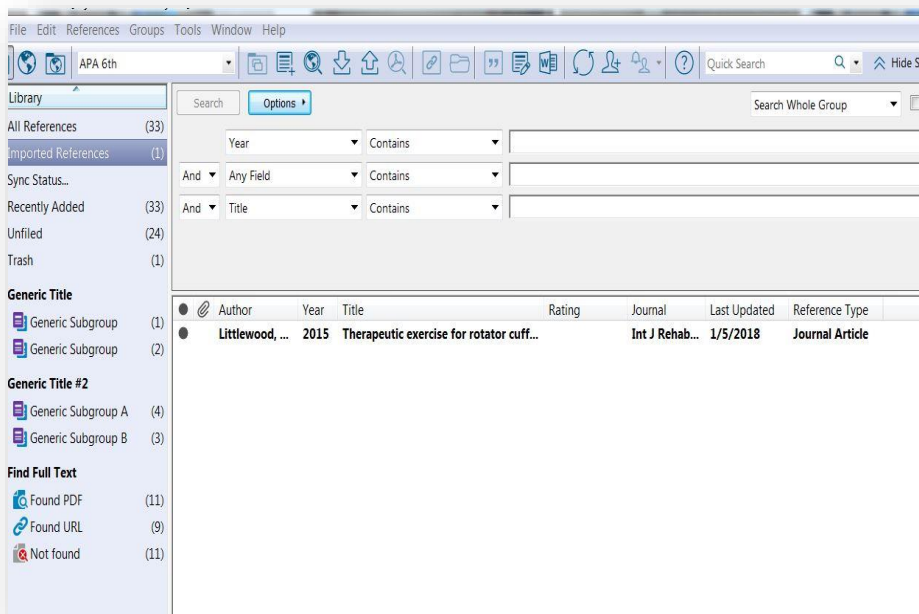
